The need for charting

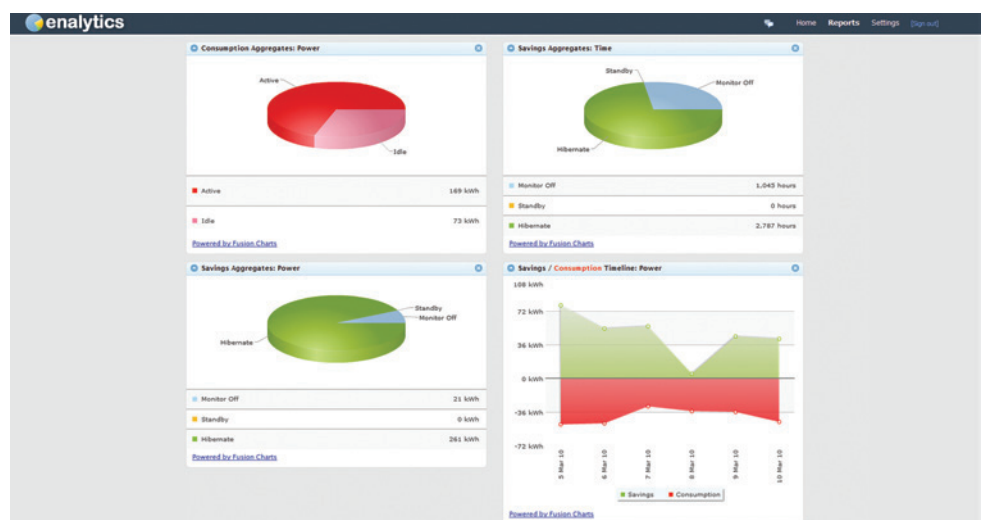
